- Here are some Rules of Thumb for your photos:
 - Include your complete name & year of Corvette (ie: John Smith 1992 LT-1).
 - Be aware of the background in your photo (try to exclude trash cans, poles, vehicles, fences, random people, parking lots lines, large shadows, etc).
 - Don't point your camera towards the sun (best to have the sun at your side).
 - Watch for excessive sun glare on your windshield or chrome.
 - Keep windows down to prevent reflection or glare
 - A "closed hood" looks better & requires less print space than an "open hood" photo.
 - Verify your email address hasn't changed since joining the club. This information must stay current.
 - For the 2025 Calendar, please submit a new or different photo of your Vette. We won't be re-using old photos. If you submit a photo, it will be in the calendar.
- Email 1 or 2 of your favorite photos to: webmaster@ccdv.com. Be sure you receive an acknowledgement email (sometimes messages with attachments are sent to the Spam folder).
- Photo submittal deadline is October 6, 2024.
- Calendars should be available for purchase at our November meeting.
